1. Headline statistics

For November 2016:

- the average price of a property in the UK was £217,928
- the annual price change for a property in the UK was 6.7%
- the monthly price change for a property in the UK was 1.1%
- the monthly index figure for the UK was 114.3 (January 2015 = 100)

Estimates for the most recent months are provisional and are likely to be updated as more data is incorporated into the index. Read the revision policies (https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/about-the-uk-house-price-index/monthly-revision).

2. Economic statement

Housing market indicators for November suggested a period of modest increasing demand and steady growth in price levels. House prices grew by 6.7% in the year to November, 0.3 percentage points higher than October. According to the Bank of England's Agents' summary

utm_medium=GOV.UK&utm_source=BEA&utm_campaign=statement&utm_term=9.30_17_01_17) of business conditions, for the final quarter of 2016 (October to December), housing market activity has recovered following a period of weakness after the EU referendum and stamp duty changes but remains weak in central London.

Between 2012 and the beginning of 2016, annual house price growth in London was generally the fastest of all regions in the UK. Annual house price growth in the East of England and the South East has now surpassed that of London for the 4th month in a row.

In terms of housing demand, the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors (http://www.rics.org/uk/) (RICS) market survey for November reported a modest increase in new buyer enquiries. According to the Bank of England (http://www.bankofengland.co.uk/statistics/Pages/bankstats/2016/nov.aspx?utm_medium=GOV.UK&utm_source=Bank-of-England-stats&utm_campaign=statement&utm_term=9.30_17_01_17), the volume of lending approvals for house purchase (seasonally adjusted) increased by 0.2% from October to November 2016, 3.7% lower than November 2015. The number of home sales in the UK (seasonally adjusted) increased by 0.8% between October and November 2016 according to UK Property Transaction statistics

(https://www.gov.uk/government/collections/property-transactions-in-the-uk?utm_medium=GOV.UK&utm_source=property-transactions-in-the-uk&utm_campaign=statement&utm_term=9.30_17_01_17), 7.3% lower than November 2015.

On the supply side, RICS reported no change in new sales listings in November 2016 compared to October 2016. ONS Construction output



Annual price change for UK by country over the past five years







Due to a period of 2 to 8 weeks between completion and registration of sales, volume figures for the most recent two months are not yet complete, so they are not included in the report.


